Covid case

New guidance on CEV pupils

Collecting children from school

Can I remind those of you who collect your children at the end of the day to do so from the main car park and not the front 'horse shoe' car park. The front car park simply does not have the capacity for more than a few cars and we need this to be kept uncongested and safe. There have been several incidents of cars stopping half in and half out of this car park, which is undesirable. We do allow a very small number of pupils to be collected from here, by special arrangement, but please do not think it is available to all.
