

Dear Parents / Carers

The new school year has started well and it has been a pleasure to get back to a far more familiar 'normal' in terms of how we run the school. However, we have recently seen a slight creeping upwards of the number of positive Covid cases, so have decided to reintroduce the wearing of face coverings. We will do this until half term and reconsider things then.

Please ensure your child has a face covering to wear. They will be expected to wear it in all indoor communal areas until they are sat in their seat in their classroom, or in their seat in the dining hall. Some teachers might ask their classes to keep their face coverings on during their lessons, and we expect pupils to cooperate with that request. If this has the desired effect we will move back to a maskless school again promptly, but will continue to monitor the number of cases we record. Can I ask that you continue to carry out twice weekly LFTs and let us know if a positive result occurs.

Can I also ask that if any of you need to visit the school for any reason you also wear a face covering. I hope you agree that this is a sensible and proactive measure. If you would like any further clarification, please contact school.
